Session Snippets

The Session met on February 11, 2023 and took these actions: Received Stewardship/Financial Report: January's Total Income was \$12,058.16. Total Expenses were \$22,347.27, resulting in deficit net income of \$10,289.21 for January. Replacing the kitchen floor and heating the Church Building and Scout Cabin accounted for a substantial portion of January expenses.

Approved the 2023 Church Budget.

Approved Fish Fry expenditures totaling \$609.49. The Fish Fry will be held on March 31-April 1, 2023.

Approved Building and Grounds Committee's motion for outside electrical work not to exceed \$1500.

Approved an increase in the church administrator's wage from \$18.05 hour to \$19/hour.

Approved the Church Sexual Misconduct Policy.
