Received and welcomed Rev. Gregory Coulter, Session Moderator appointed by Presbytery's Commission on Ministry during this time of transition.

Held a joint meeting with the Board of Deacons and Session Elders.

Acknowledged Presbytery's letter noting two elder commissioners may represent Covenant at Presbytery's 2022 meetings. Letha Chadiha and Walt Grainger will represent Covenant at Presbytery's 2022 meetings.

Received January's Financial & Stewardship Report: January's Total Income was \$20,695.94; Total Expenses were \$11,395.42, resulting in net income of \$9,300.52

Passed a motion giving tentative approval of the 2022 Church Budget and authorizing Stewardship to make modifications to the budget for the Annual Meeting on February 20.

Worship with Second Presbyterian Church

On March 6, we have a special worship service planned with our mission partners at Second Presbyterian Church at 10 A.M.

You may recall that we had a worship service together with them last year on Zoom. We would like to make this joint worship an annual event, alternating from year-to-year from one location to the other.

This year, those who are willing and able will gather together at **Second Presbyterian Church, 318 E 55th St, Kansas City, MO 64113** (at the corner of 55th and Oak.) The service will include our musicians, Second's choir and worship leaders from both congregations.

Please note that the service will begin at 10 A.M., rather than our usual 10:30 A.M. That time is midway between our regular worship time and Second's regular time.

If anyone forgets to travel to Second, the Zoom session will be available for viewing in the sanctuary at Covenant. But it would be especially meaningful to be worshipping together in the same location.

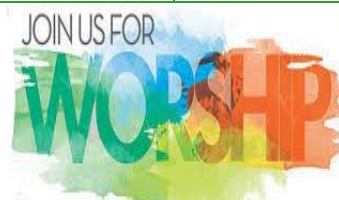
